Buses 8106, 8114, 8115, 8117, and 8118 are equipped with **"Child Reminder Systems."** The "alarm" is programmed to give the operator 30 seconds to go to the rear of the bus to de-activate the system. If the operator does not go to the rear of the bus to de-activate within the 30-second period, the horn will begin to blow. The following procedure should be followed to de-activate the Child Reminder System:

1. TURN IGNITION SWITCH OFF.
2. LEAVE ENTRANCE DOOR OPENING SWITCH IN THE CLOSED POSITION.
3. GO TO THE REAR OF THE BUS AND CHECK FOR STUDENTS. ONCE YOU ARE AT THE REAR OF THE BUS, DEPRESS THE DE-ACTIVATION BUTTON THAT IS LOCATED OVER THE REAR DOOR. INTERIOR LIGHTS WILL STAY ON AFTER THEY BLINK 2 TIMES AND PROVIDE LIGHT FOR THE OPERATOR TO GO BACK TO THE FRONT OF THE BUS.
4. PLACE THE AIR DOOR RELEASE HANDLE LOCATED IN THE FRONT HEADER PANEL IN THE EMERGENCY POSITION. THIS WILL ALLOW THE OPERATOR TO PUSH THE ENTRANCE DOORS OPEN AND EXIT THE BUS.
